

## 2025 Clipper Day Camp T-Shirt Policy

Campers **must wear their 2025 Clipper Day Camp T-shirt** on all field trips to public locations—**no exceptions**. Shirts must remain on at all times, including in and out of the water. If your child is uncomfortable in a wet shirt (grades 2-5 only), we recommend purchasing an extra T-shirt for them to change into during the trip.

### T-Shirt Distribution & Pricing:

- Each camper receives **one T-shirt per summer** with weekly registrations.
- Full Summer registrations include **two T-shirts**.
- Additional T-shirts are **\$10** if purchased before or at sign-in on trip day.
- If a camper arrives without a required T-shirt, one will be provided for **\$15**.

For campers in **grades 2-5**, we have selected quick-dry material for added comfort and safety. For campers in grades K-1 Only **official 2024 and 2025 Clipper Day Camp T-shirts** (correct color and logo) are allowed on designated camp shirt days.
